

# **Lumber Market Report**



On the heels of last week's activity, framing lumber markets headed into the U.S. Thanksgiving with a head of steam.

Many traders vacated early for the holiday, and some buyers were content to digest recent purchases. However, supply concerns fueled by the logistical uncertainties in British Columbia kept others active. More heavy rain was forecast for the province this week and into the weekend.

Some traders turned their attention to the first quarter, with a growing number of mills reporting order files through or nearly through the remainder of 2021. Producers kept upward pressure on quotes, aggressively in some cases, as order files were extended. Mills in the West benefited from the transportation difficulties in B.C., which were also a catalyst in an abrupt shift in Southern Pine trading. SYP sales picked up starting late last week, and recent discounting dissipated on many items.

Lumber traders waited for news from the U.S. Department of Commerce on the new duty rates on Canadian lumber shipments to the U.S. A public announcement on the second administrative review of the duties was expected November 24. Interfor's announced acquisition of Eacom drew attention.



# **Dry Framing Lumber**

#### **Southern Pine**

A firming trend that formed late last week gained momentum through Tuesday. Sales hit a higher gear as the week began, allowing mills to alleviate buildups that accumulated amid lethargic demand in previous weeks. Many traders noted that the Southern Pine market reacted in large part to the shipping upheaval in Western Canada.

The sudden momentum shift was most evident in #2 2x6; prices gained in all zones. Discounts dissipated in most other widths. Reported prices spanned a wider range in most items. Some producers sought steep premiums, but sales at the highest quoted levels were thin. Lower grades remained tight, and buyers paid premiums to secure coverage. Timbers were mixed. Decking prices were firm to higher.

#### **Western Spruce-Pine-Fir**

Trading was measured amid the holiday week in the U.S. and buyers' digestion of recent purchases. Mills had limited offerings, but sold at higher prices on the items they did have. Some mills hiked quotes defensively or were off the market amid pending duty increases and shipping uncertainties. Producers' efforts to ship were stymied by road closures and restrictions in the wake of severe flooding and mudslides caused by a mid-November storm. The Coast and Lower Mainland regions were bracing for more heavy rain this week and into the weekend.

### **Eastern Spruce-Pine-Fir**

Eastern S-P-F traders noted a less active market, largely attributed to the lack of offerings. Mills steadily raised quotes and kept selling; traders noted buyers accepted prices that incorporated higher duties on Canadian offerings. With order files often pushed into mid-December, some producers pulled off the market or priced defensively. In #1&2 dimension, gains were sharpest on 2x4.

#### **Futures**

The upward trend cooled off early in the week, after the January contract had surged to a \$200-plus premium to cash, inviting basis trading. January hit a high for the week of \$831.80 on Monday, before falling back to a \$772.60 settlement.

Moderate recovery Tuesday pushed the front month up to \$779.40. The cash market advanced on light activity, but tight supplies at the mills. Sales were measured, as buyers pulled back to digest recent purchases and observe the U.S. holiday.

#### Coast

Steady sales sustained upward pressure on Hem-Fir and Douglas Fir prices. Availability remained limited at some mills, which contributed to price ranges in #2&Btr narrows of \$40-50. Consumers turned their attention to the holidays, slowing sales at box stores.

Producers aggressively increased quotes on Douglas Fir #1&Btr 2x4, with sales reported as high as \$980. Significant demand prompted higher prices in both Utility/#3 and Economy.

#### Inland

The pace of sales in #2&Btr was hindered by the approaching long holiday weekend in the U.S., but traders still in their offices were active early in the week. Prices across species, grades, and widths were firm to higher.

Logistics disorder in B.C. led some buyers to substitute Inland species to cover immediate needs. This was especially true on shipments destined for the Pacific Northwest and California.

# **Green Framing Lumber**

#### Douglas Fir

Buoyed by a strong finish to last week, green Fir producers raised quotes aggressively on the narrow widths of Std/#2&Btr dimension. Quotes covered a \$50 spread on some items. The biggest jump was reported on Std&Btr 2x4, which finished \$35 higher at Portland-rate mills.

Quotes covered a \$470-520 range on Tuesday. A number of buyers in California said they were surprised by the strong price increases; many described their business as "so-so." Mills continued to report strong sales to nontraditional markets.

Double-digit increases prevailed in long lengths; order files on 22&lgr extended through December at some mills. Following a recent lull, activity in low grade picked up, and prices of Utility, #3, and Economy gained \$20-25.

### Stud Lumber

Trading was subdued in part by the holiday week; prices advanced unevenly. Supplies tightened in Western S-P-F as buyers cleaned up mill offerings and producers let customers know shipments were subject to transportation limitations amid recent mudslides and flooding. In Eastern S-P-F, doubledigit gains were the rule. 2x4-9s showed the most strength in all markets, followed by 2x4-8s.

Prices of green Fir studs posted double-digit increases as strong order files and steady demand kept buyers in the market. Demand at Coast mills remained strong, boosting prices and constricting availability. 2x4 9-footers led the gains, rising \$40. Sales of Inland species were active early as traders covered needs ahead of the U.S. Thanksgiving.

### Other Items

#### **Boards**

Recent trends in western species were unabated. A moderately stronger pace continued to develop

in Ponderosa Pine, led by 1x8 in all grades. Mill production was sparse; buyers stepped in readily when needs arose. Most prices of Ponderosa Pine were firm to higher.

Sales of ES-LP and Idaho White Pine were thin amid a dearth of production in those species. Small volumes sold in mixed loads at or slightly above recently reported levels. Demand for Cedar remained strong, but a few prices eased lower.

Southern Pine sales were uneventful. Prices of #2 narrows were sloppy and spanned wide ranges. Demand for Eastern White Pine ran in step with production, leaving few buildups. Prices were firm across grades and widths.

#### Shop

Reported prices of industrial lumber were firm at established levels. Upper grades of Ponderosa Pine shop remained difficult to source due to limited log availability. Demand for 6/4 went unmet, and supported occasional premiums.

Buyers mostly retreated to the sidelines to digest inventories and assess needs for the remainder of the year. Supplies of Radiata Pine shop and blanks out of Chile were scarce.

#### **Treated**

Sales were mixed in the holiday-shortened week. New orders slowed in the Southeast. Demand from contractor yards faded.

Many buyers delayed replenishment, hoping for lower prices in the weeks ahead. Sales to home centers rebounded in the Northeast. Inquiries sought prompt shipment.

#### Cedar

The trading pace picked up for some, especially for orders to deliver in the new year. Others waited to see where the market settles amid myriad factors. Higher duties, transportation backups due to last week's flooding in British Columbia, and old-growth restrictions were all issues. Reports circulated of excess T&G siding selling at discounts.

### Shingles & Shakes

Demand continued to outpace supplies. Transportation delays due to last week's flooding in British Columbia exacerbated the situation. Buyers snatched up offerings as they surfaced, afraid of going without or paying more down the road.
